First placing owned by J McNamara (Victoria) although missing a spot has beautiful release of feather on the head and skull.

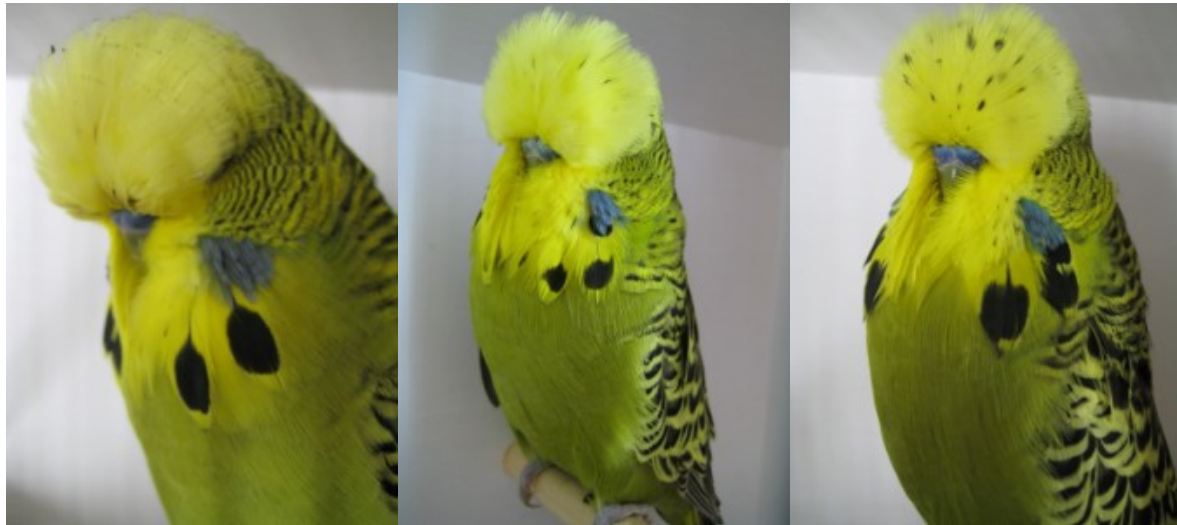
Second bird owned by Peter Thurn (Victoria) showed well but not quite has the cap release of the winning bird but still very nice. Mask was not as deep as the first placing either.

## Judges Comments:

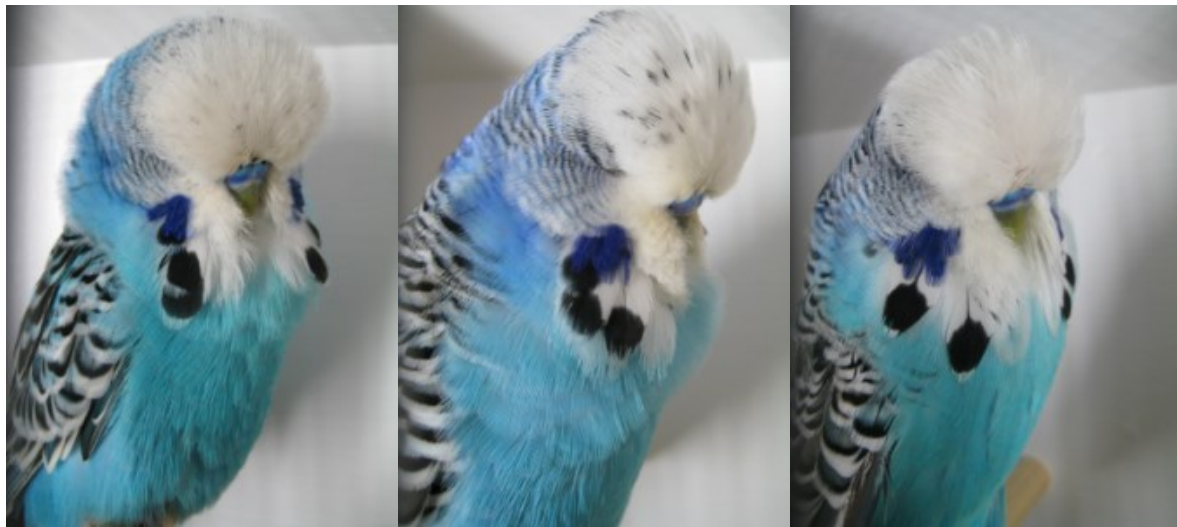

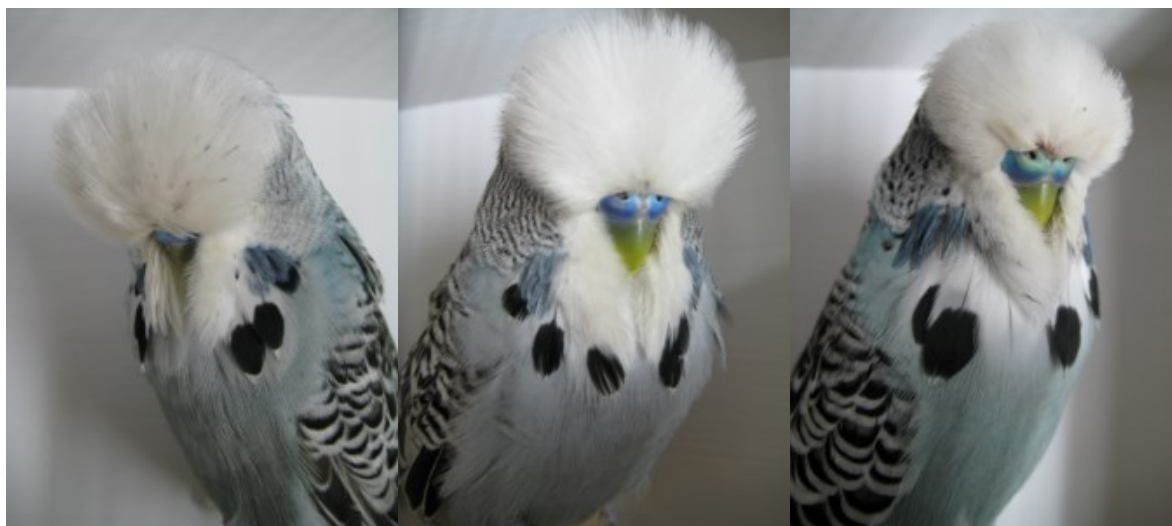

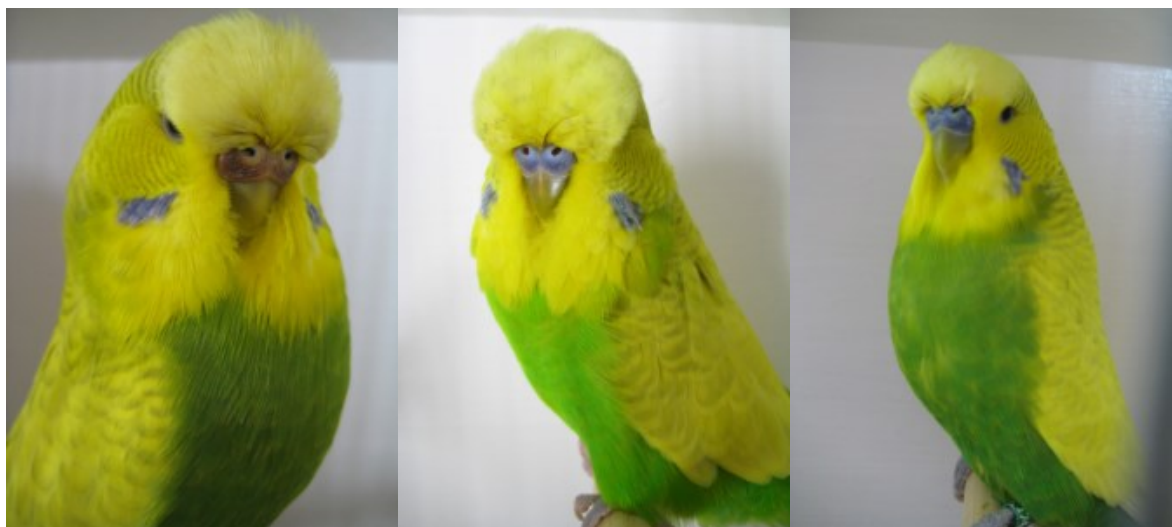
First bird owned by Mark Hawke (NSW) is a strong hen with the modern features we are looking for.

Second placing owned by Kakoschke & Rice (South Australia) is a nice cock bird but smaller than the winner.

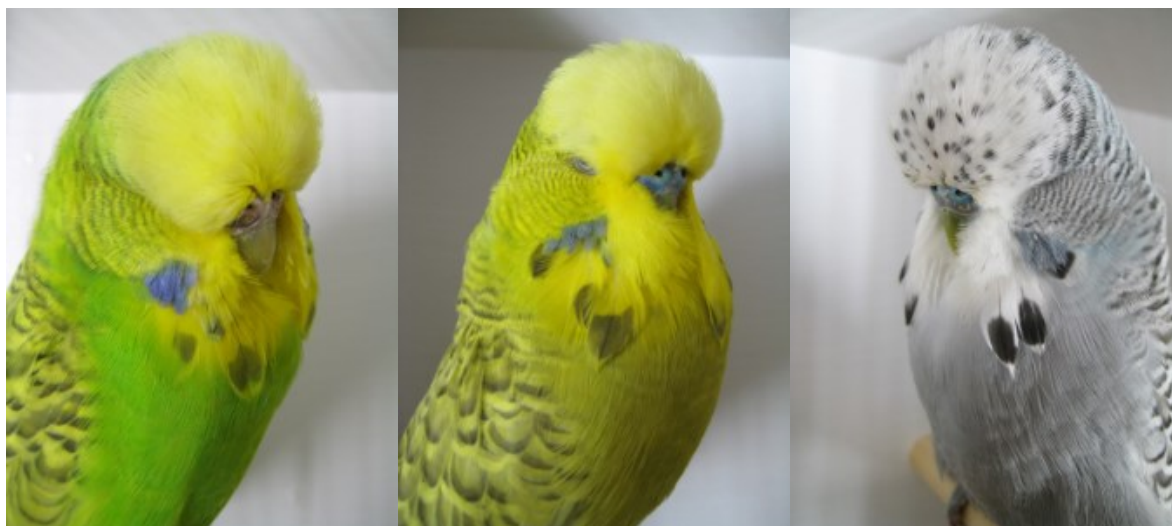
Third owned by Blair & Poole (Tasmania) is a good variety bird but lacking the modern features.

A super class of birds presented here today.

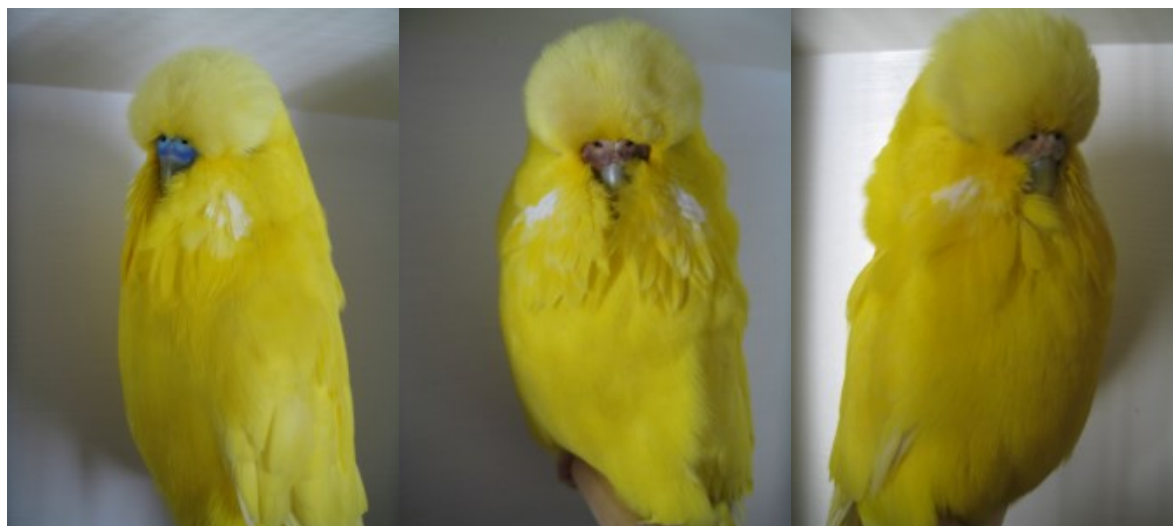
Winner owned by John Richardson (NSW) is a powerful Cinnamon sky blue who does have a slight flight problem but is far superior in qualities.

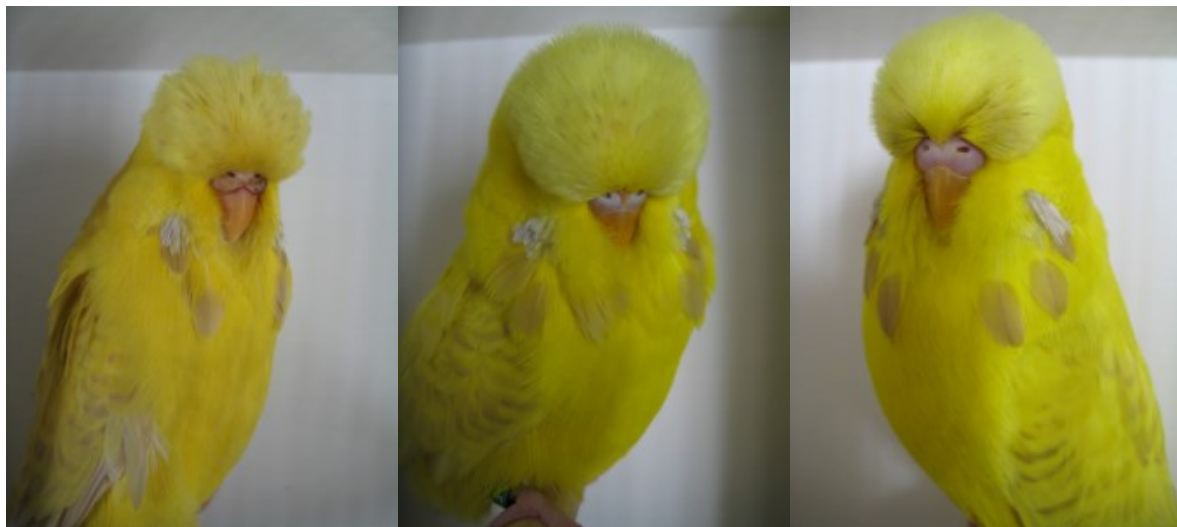
