**Postal entry Option 1:** Entry fee to accompany the entry form with a stamped self addressed envelope and cheque or money order payable to the BSSA.

**Postal entry Option 2:** Send stamped self addressed envelope with entry form and pay on the day. **Email Option:** Email electronic version of the entry form and pay on the day, <u>but adding additional \$1.00 for</u> postage and handling.

**<u>BIRDS</u>** to be benched between 8-30 = 9-15 am Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.

Four birds shall constitute a class. The Show Committee shall reserve the right to combine classes

All exhibits to be presented in Standard Show Cages approved be B.S.S.A. Novices and Juniors <u>may</u> use old style cages.

The Safety Officer has the right to reject entries prior to judging for signs of illness, deformity or poorly prepared Show Cages that are deemed hazardous or unhealthy to all the birds. Birds are exhibited at the risk of the owner, but the Show Committee will exercise all due care.

Cages to be fitted with a White D drinker ½ full with seed in it. On the bottom wire fixed near the door. White paper or plastic insert on floor of cage. Equal parts Canary, Jap and White Millet are the only seed permitted. Each cage to be fitted with a drinker (dry) with the position for old cages being five spaces in from the left on the base wire, New cages four spaces in level with the perch.

Stickers are to be placed on the bottom left hand side of the Show Cage. Hot Weather Policy applies.
