Exhibitors to mark entries, Intermediate, Novice or Junior.

## NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Postal entry Option 1: Entry fee to accompany the entry form with a stamped self addressed envelope and cheque or money order payable to the Budgerigar Society of SA Inc.

Postal entry Option 2: Send stamped self addressed envelope with entry form and pay entry fee at the door in sealed envelope labeled with name and amount as per entry form (donation optional)

Email Option: Email electronic version of the entry form and pay at the door on the day when birds presented, as just described, but adding additional \$1.00 for postage and handling

Birds to be benched between 8-30 to 9-15 am, presentation of awards approx 2.00 pm.

All birds are to be presented in standard show cages approved by the B.S.S.A. <u>Cages to be fitted with a White D drinker HALF FILLED with equal parts of Seed Canary, Jap, White Millet. No seed on floor of cage.</u>

D drinker to be fixed on bottom wire near the door.

Each cage to be fitted with a drinker (dry) with the position for old cages being five spaces in from the left on the base wire, new cages four spaces in level with the perches.

Stickers to be placed on the bottom left hand side of the Show Cage.

All birds are to be rung with a PURPLE 2015 closed ring but must be Nest Feather.

The Safety Officer has the right to reject entries prior to Judging for illness, deformity or <u>poorly</u> <u>prepared</u> Show Cages that are deemed hazardous or unhealthy to the birds.

Birds are exhibited at the owners risk, but the Show Committee will exercise all due care.

Five birds shall constitute a class. The Show Committee shall reserve the right to combine classes.

INTERCLUB POINTS shall be awarded to the best six placed birds in each variety.

HOT WEATHER POLICY: In the event of the temperature being forecast 32c or above as per the night before the Show (6.00 p.m. T.V. Weather Report) the show will be cancelled.

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the weather forecast.
