Second owned by R & C Ogden (Q'land North & Central Zone) is another clean Dark Green Hen, very strong who was just shaded by the winner.

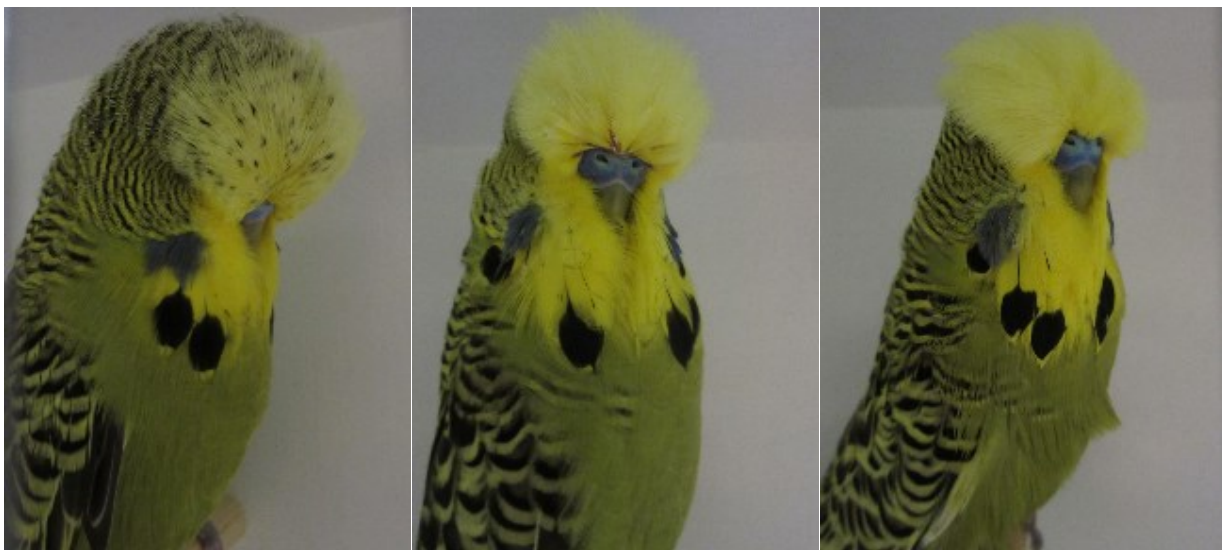
Third owned by Henry George (South Queensland) is a very nice clean Light Green cock but just couldn't match the first two strong hens.

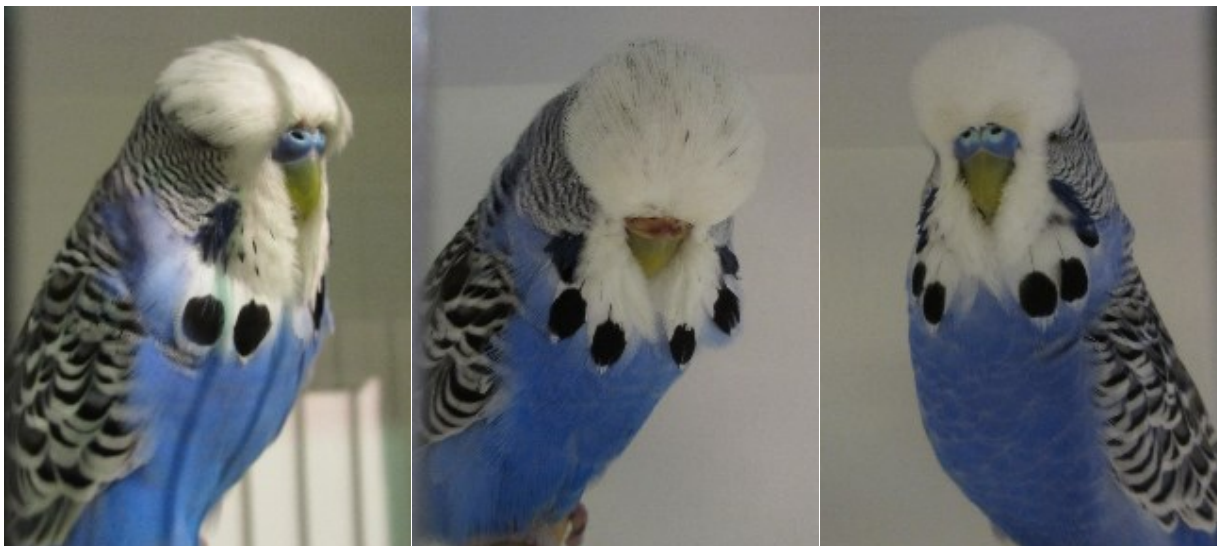

Third owned by Jupp & Scheerer (New South Wales) is a strong cock but didn't challenge the first two. A solid bird.

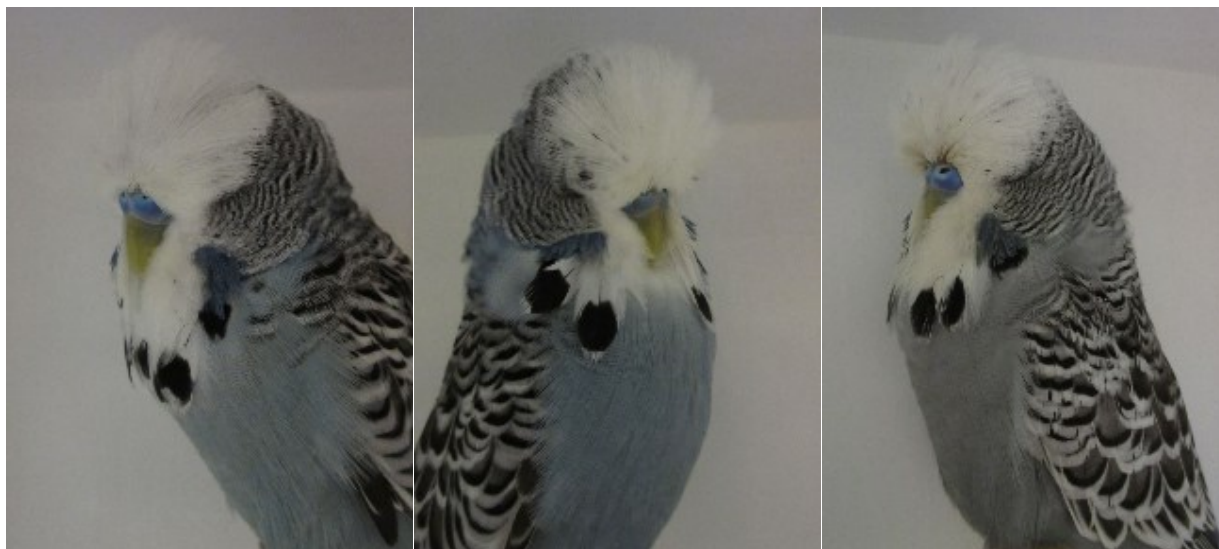

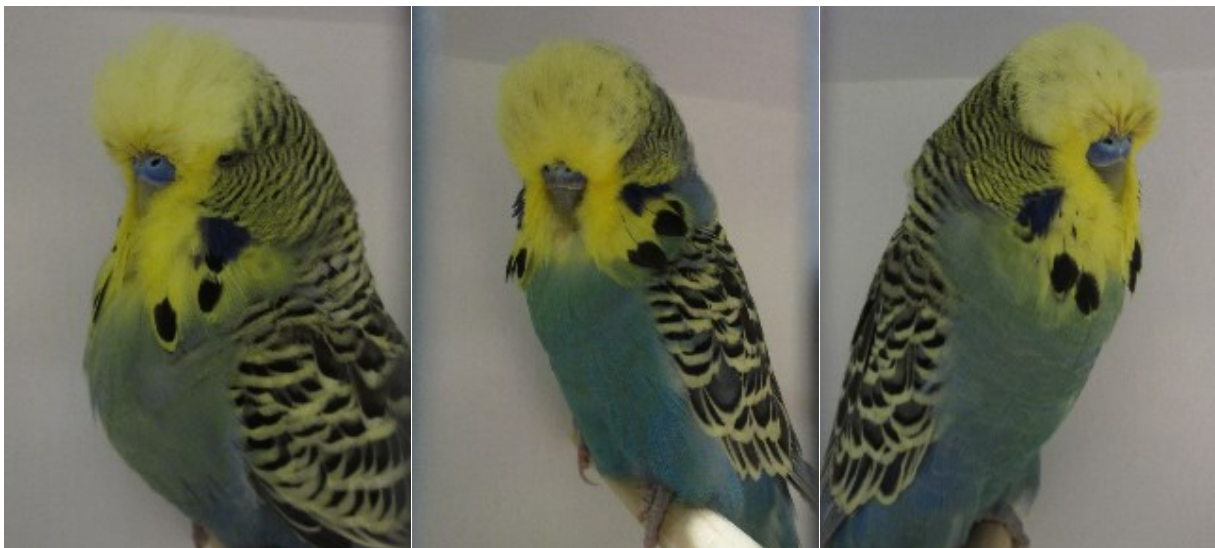
Third owned by Mark Hawke (New South Wales) has excellent feather direction and good condition but marginally smaller than the first two birds.

First owned by Andrew Clifton (New South Wales) is a very strong outstanding bird.

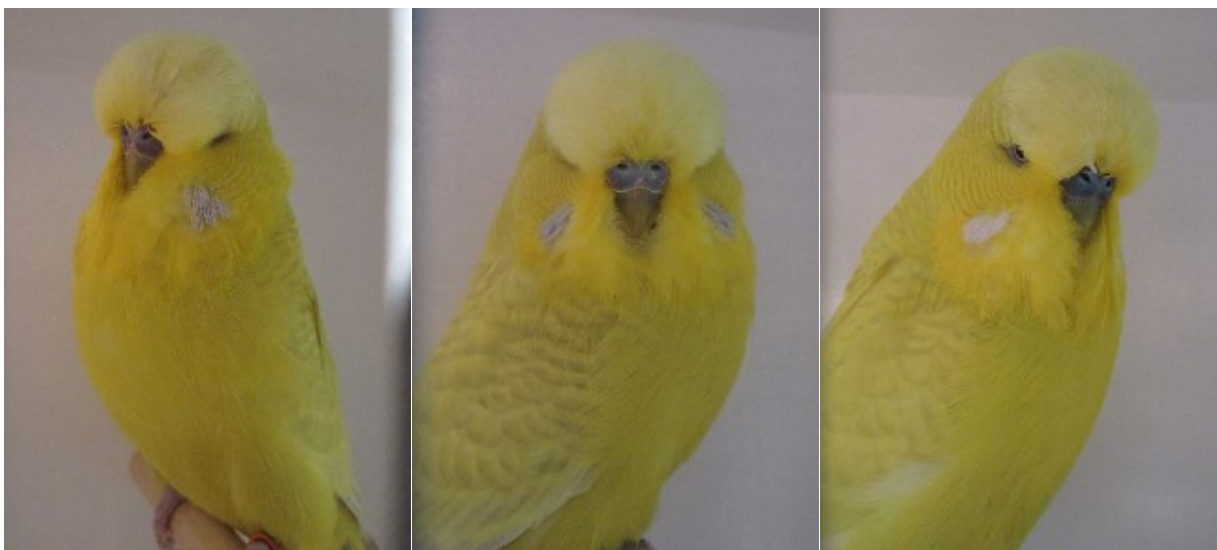

Fourth owned by R & C Ogden (Q'land North & Central Zone) is a nice variety yellow but will not perch to his disadvantage.

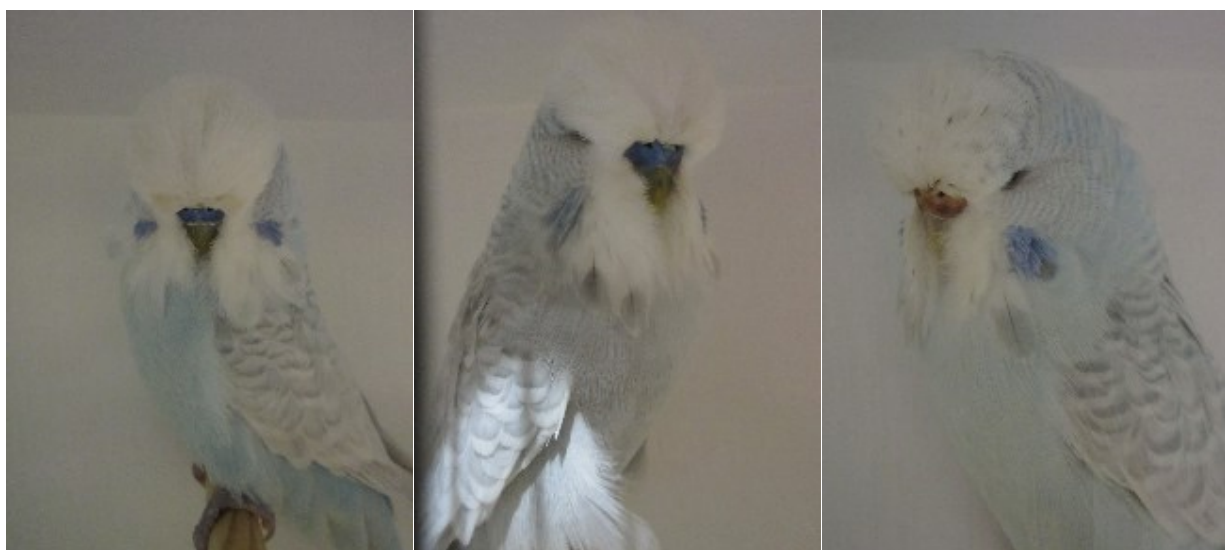
Fifth owned by Rowe Brothers (Victoria) has nice variety, unfortunately lies across the perch and not as strong in presentation as those placed above it.

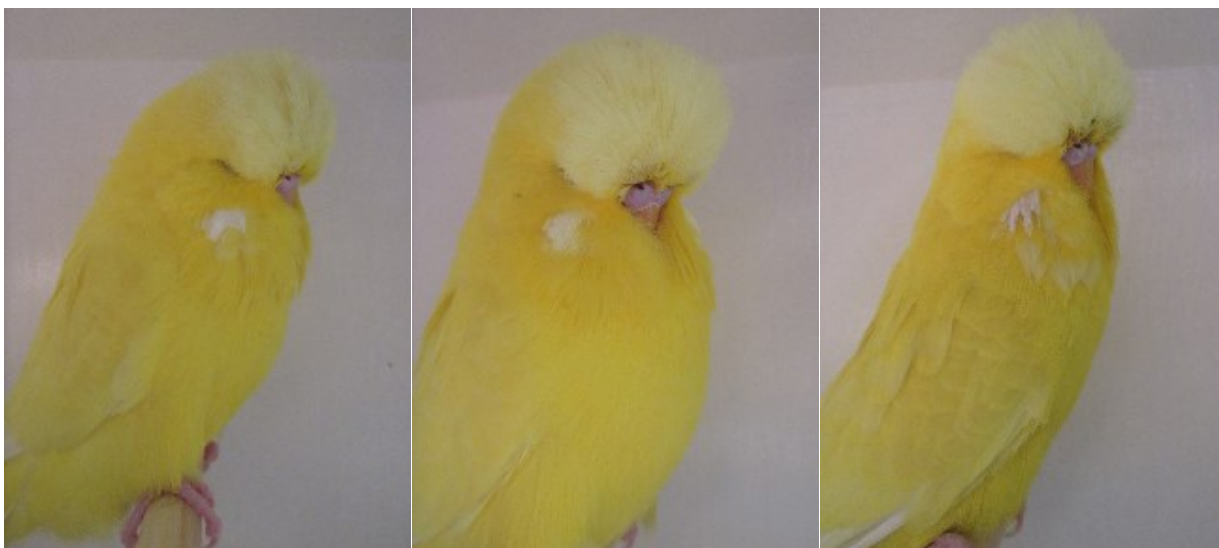
Second owned by Brett & Danny Card (South Queensland) is a Grey Dilute unfortunately not in full condition and had a tendency to spread his flights.

Second owned by Shiralee Reardon (South Australia) is a strong shouldered bird with good width of face and depth of mask.

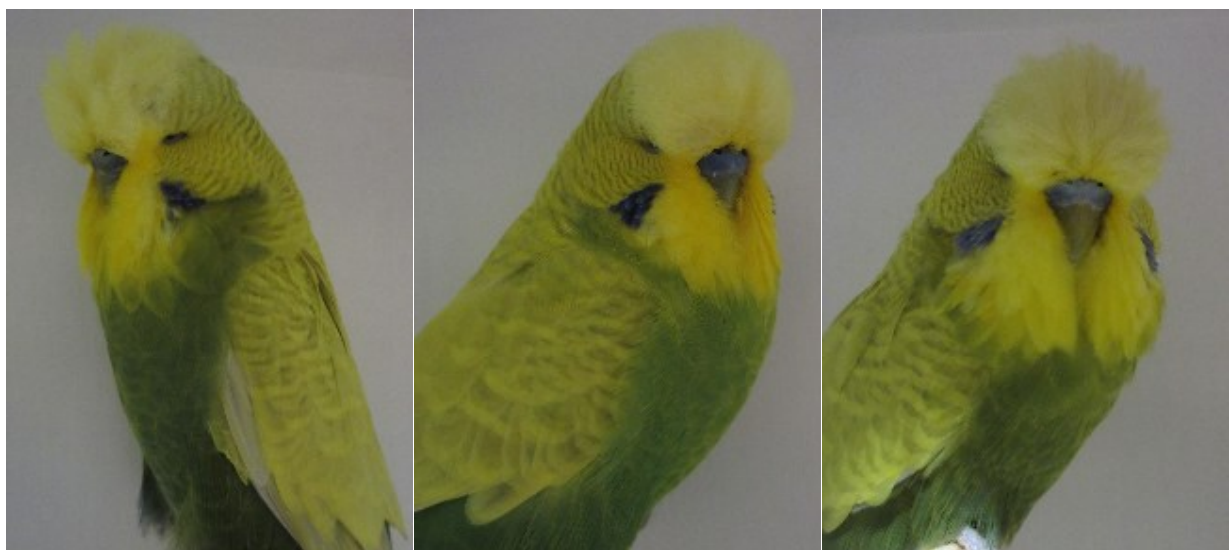
Third owned by Wright Family (South Queensland) is a long big bird with good style.

Fourth owned by A Buffa (Q'land North & Central Zone) is a nicely marked Grey with good variety but just too small to be placed higher.

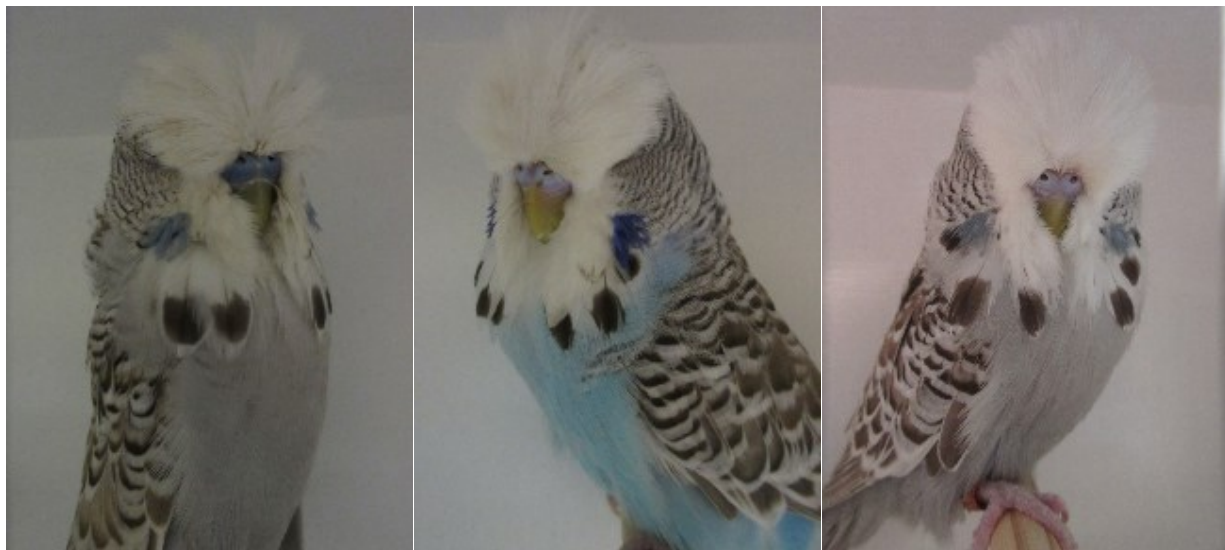
The best bird benched is in cage L owned by Alan Baxter (Victoria) but had to be disqualified due to dropping both tail feathers.

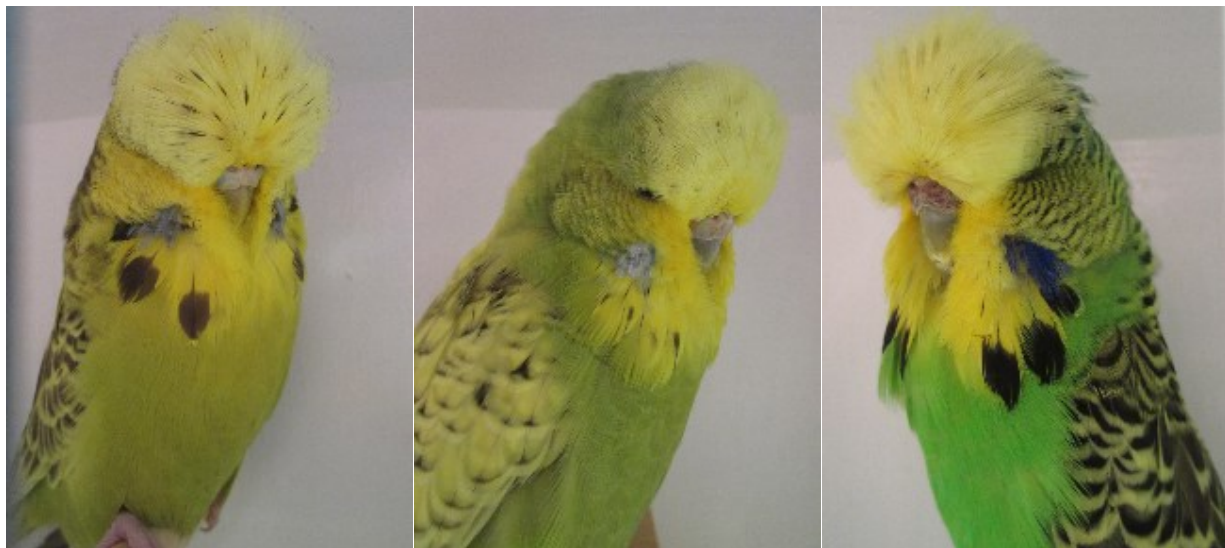
